**GLADWIN COUNTY PLUMBING FEES**

**Item #2, Mobile Home Unit Site:** When item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. When setting a mobile home or doublewide in a park, or a mobile or doublewide home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain and a water service or water distribution pipe. **Modular homes** may require more connections.

**Item #21, Domestic Water Treatment and Filtering Equipment:** A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #21 for \$5.00 each, and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

**IX. Instructions for Completing Application**

**General:** Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Gladwin County Construction Codes Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** The telephone number of the Plumbing Dept./inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the office providing as much advance notice as possible. Have the township, address & property owner's name when scheduling.

**Expiration of Permit:** A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
